20.1: To approve the Minutes of previous Academic Council meeting held on 23/09/2021.

The Academic Council has approved the minutes of previous Academic Council meeting held on 23-09-2021.

20.2: To review and approve BOS Minutes of various Programmes.

Dr K.Sivaji Babu, Principal presented the minutes of the BOS meetings of various Programmes held in April 2022 and is ratified by the Academic Council.

20.3: To discuss and approve III & IV B.Tech. Course Structure & Syllabus of PVP20 Regulations.

The Academic Council has thoroughly discussed and approved III & IV B.Tech Course Structure and Syllabus of PVP20 Regulations with the following suggestions.

- German Language Course shall be introduced to the students in Open Elective Category.
- In III B.Tech II Semester Course Structure of Civil Engineering Department, "Design of Steel Structures" subject shall be changed as "Design & Drawing of Steel Structures".
- In III B.Tech II Semester Course Structure of ECE, EEE & IT departments, Practice Sessions (Practical Component) shall be incorporated in "Soft Skills" course under skill advanced course category with L-T-P as 1-0-2 for 2 credits.
- In IV B.Tech I Semester Course Structure of CSE department, "Entrepreneurship Management" Course shall be changed as "Entrepreneurship Development" under HSS elective category.
- In IV B.Tech II Semester Course Structure, "Project work, Seminar and Internship in Industry" course duration shall be changed to one Semester instead of 6 Months.
- In IV B.Tech II Semester Course Structure, "Project work, Seminar and Internship in Industry" course hours expected to work per week shall be mentioned as 40 Hours.
- 20.4: To discuss and approve the Syllabus of B.Tech. Honors and B.Tech. Minor degree Courses of all programmes.

Dr K.Sivaji Babu, Principal presented the syllabus of Honors and Minor courses of all the Programmes.

The Academic Council has unanimously approved the Syllabus of B.Tech Honors and B.Tech Minor Courses of all programmes.

20.5: To discuss the CGPA and SGPA eligibility criteria for B.Tech Minor degree Program.

Dr K.Sivaji Babu, Principal presented the following amendment with respect to the CGPA and SGPA eligibility criteria for B.Tech Minor degree program.

- In PVP20 Regulations, students having CGPA of 8 or above without any backlogs will be permitted to register for Minor Program.
- But, it is proposed that students having CGPA and SGPA of 7.75 or above without any backlogs will be permitted to register for Minor Program as per JNTUK guidelines.
- Students registered for Minor in a discipline must pass in all subjects with a minimum GPA of 7.75 that constitute requirement for award of Minor degree.

It is resolved to approve the amendment in B.Tech PVP20 Curriculum w.e.f A.Y 2022-23.

20.6: To discuss the eligibility criteria (PG Program/ NBA Accreditation) for offering B.Tech Honors Degree & CGPA and SGPA eligibility criteria for B.Tech Honors degree Program.

The Academic Council approved that institutions having at least two NBA accredited B.Tech Programs are eligible to offer B.Tech Honors Degree courses.

The Academic Council also approved that students having CGPA and SGPA of 8 or above without any backlogs will be permitted to register for Honors Degree Program and students registered for Honors degree in a discipline must register and pass in all subjects with a minimum GPA of 8.0 that constitute requirement for award of Honors degree.

20.7 To discuss and approve Industrial/Research Summer Internship (Mandatory) for II & III B.Tech students.

The Academic Council approved Industrial/ Research Summer Internship for II & III B.Tech students and members suggested that internship shall be carried out in a span of 4 to 6 weeks duration during summer break period or during academic session period.

20.8: To discuss and approve M.Tech. (PVP22) Academic Regulations, M.Tech. (Machine Design) and M.Tech. (Microwave and Communication Engineering) Program Structure & Syllabus of PVP22 Regulations.
